Leading Physician Groups: Patients in Minnesota Deserve Access to Health Care

The statement below is issued by the American Academy of Family Physicians, the American Academy of Pediatrics, the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists and the American College of Physicians:

“Health care settings must remain safe spaces where patients can seek care without fear and clinicians can provide confidential care without interference. The ongoing crisis in Minnesota and other communities across the U.S. is directly harming patients and families, compromising their health, stripping them of dignity and creating dangerous barriers to essential care. Frontline physicians and health care workers are facing unprecedented strain—experiencing fear for their patients and themselves—affecting their own well-being and the health of the communities that depend on them. These consequences undermine the very foundations our health care system was built upon: unfettered access to safe, high-quality care for everyone.”
